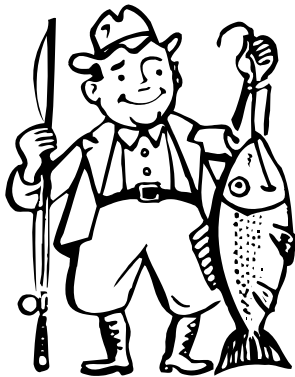

Lunches
